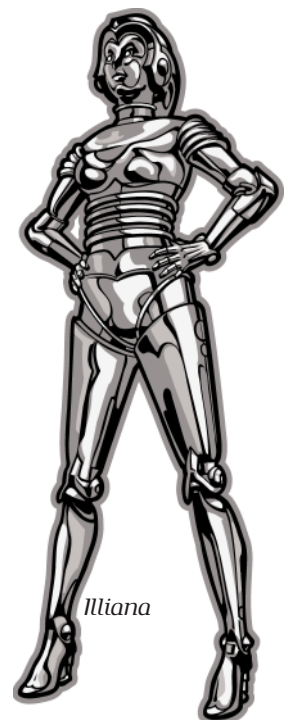
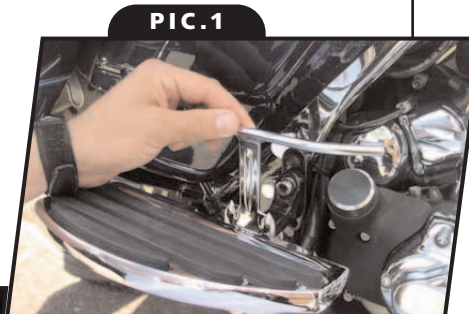
PROCEDURE AVERAGE TIME: 15 MINUTES

STEP 1 Position Passenger Heel Guard on stock passenger footboard mount. The ends of the round rod should curve inward. The Heel Guard can be moved in or out along the mount based on personal preference or potential interference with existing accessories. (PIC.1)

STEP 2 Install the clamp and secure it with the two 1/4"-20 x 1-1/4" socket head cap screws provided. (PIC.2)

STEP 3 Make any final adjustments to the Passenger Heel Guard's position and then tighten the clamp screws securely with a 3/16" hex key.
